HIPPA is an EU-funded pilot initiative that considers possible Indo-Pacific-wide mechanisms for hybrid threats. The overall objective of the initiative is to develop regional cooperation and address between the EU and (government, non-government, and industry) which approaches to this topic. This is done through assessing and addressing in the Indo-Pacific, covering intimidation and sabotage, foreign interference, strategic infrastructure protection, disinformation, motivated violence; (2) stakeholder consultation, roundtable conversations, with sharing insights and (3) recommendation for a future more permanent coordination in hybrid threats to
